## STOVE VILMAR

## user manual

## STARTING:

- \* Remove the cover (estetic top)
- \* **Open** (put in the vertical) the "smoke outlet" valve.
- \* Open the "air inlet".
- \* Do not remove the ashes. It 'does not matter, just leave them!
- \* Place a **fire cube** (ignited) in the combustion chamber by opening the door for starting the fire. The space is a bit tight.
- \* Add some pieces of **small wood**.
- \* After a minute: Add larger pieces from the opening above by removing the flat top cover with the special tool.
- \* When the heater is heated: **close** "air inlet"
- \* **Do not close the smoke outlet**. Leave it open or half closed, otherwise smoke will come out.
- \* Keep the stove on by adding a piece of wood (from the top) once in a while.

## RULES:

- \* Do not experiment: every stove has its own operation. Always ask if you are not sure!
- \* Do not leave the doors of the stove and the flat top cover open.
- \* Remove large pieces of wood if they are not fitting.
- \* Do not touch the transparent material of the middle door.
- \* Do not put candles on or near the stove.
- \* Do not burn plastic or plasticized paper: we reuse the ashes in the garden.
- \* Avoid spraying water on the stove when showering.
- \* Do not put the flat top cover on the floor
