## STOVE Wasseralfingen

## In enamelled cast iron 1930-1940 User manual

## STARTING:

- \* Open the "smoke outlet" valve towards auf.
- \* Open "air inlet".
- \* Do not remove **ash**. Don't worry.
- \* Put a **fire cube** (lit) in the mini combustion chamber by opening the internal door. The space is very tight because it is originally a stove for coal.
- \* Do not start the fire in the ash container.
- \* Add some pieces of **small wood**.
- \* Close the inside and outside door.
- \* After a minute: **add other pieces** through the "wood charge" door and close the door otherwise it will smoke.
- \* When the stove is burning well: **Close** "air inlet" toward **zu**.
- \* **Keep the stove on** by placing a piece of wood onve in a while. Use small pieces and do not force them in, because that will break the fragile refractories inside,

## RULES:

- \* Do not experiment: every stove has its own way of handling. Ask!
- \* Do not leave the doors of the stove open.
- \* Remove large pieces of wood if they don't fit.
- \* Do not put candles on or near the stove.
- \* Do not put anything on top of the stove
- \* Do not burn plastic or plasticized paper: we reuse ash in the garden.
- \* Do not put containers or glasses with water on the stove. Not even to moisten the air!
- \* Do not remove or open the cover.
